The Applicant has read and understood the ACSKG Guide Requirements (www.acskg.ca/standards) and agrees to follow ACSKG Standards to the best of their ability, for all their commercial sea kayak tours in Canada. Additionally, the Applicant agrees to follow ACSKG Minimum Impact Standards (www.acskg.ca/impact) and maintain a high level of competency with each category of the ACSKG Leadership Course Core Curriculum (www.acskg.ca/curriculum).

The following points are extracted from ACSKG Standards:

- Clients must remain between the two guides and within vocal range of the guides while on the water.
- In mixed kayak fleets (doubles & singles), the full guide must be in a single kayak.
- Guides will store food away from tent sites and hang food in a cache overnight and when the camp is not occupied.
- Minimal deck loads are required in order to maximize the seaworthiness of each kayak.
